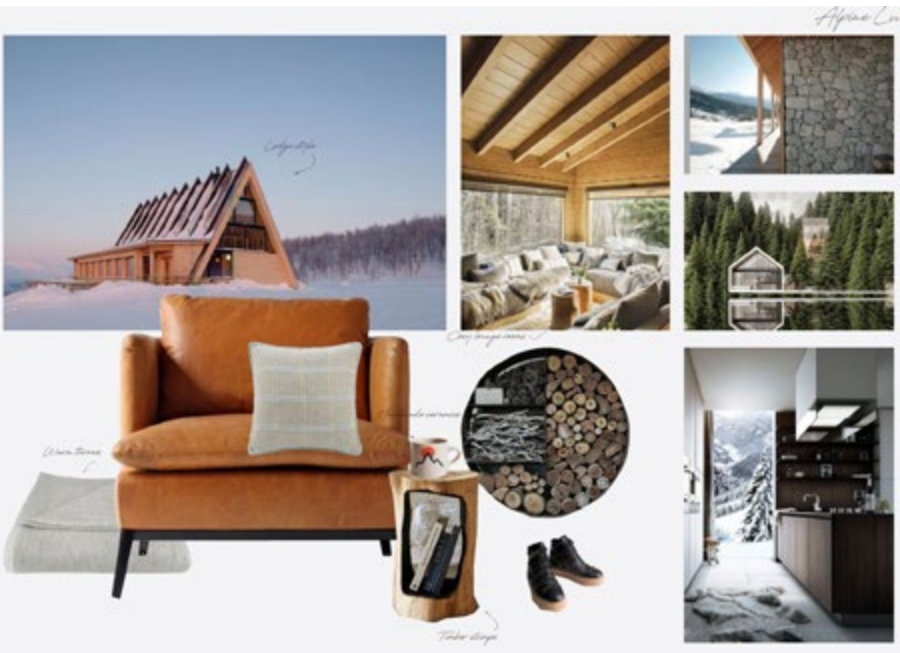


ALPINE LUXE

- Feature wood panelling, stone walls, timber flooring and textured flagstone floors
- Rustic exposed timbers from massive timber beams to petrified wood stump side tables
- A wood-burning fireplace should take centre stage
- Make a statement with leather, textured timber or stone cladding
- Accessorize with all things animal - real or faux (cowhide rugs, fur throws, sheepskins and fly-fishing paraphernalia)
- Bring in cosy layers of texture with bursts of colour to add warmth (cable-knit pillows, oversized plush sofas and tufted ottomans)
- Create zones with loads of comfy seating
- Rugs are ideal for smaller spaces within larger areas.
- The kitchen should be an open space with timber floorboards, roof rafters and joinery
- A mudroom is ideal
