- White floors, walls and wooden furniture are key

- Minimal window treatments – plantation shutters, bamboo blinds or muslin curtain panels at most.
- Big, comfy sofas and armchairs, linen fabrics, slipcovers, floaty sheers and pure white or washed out pastels
- A casual elegance is important - with restraint.
- Choose barely-there blues and coastal colours
- Hints of classic nautical hues like navy and white can look fresh too.
- Light and weathered woods work perfectly, timbers worn smooth and bleached out.
