- White-washed walls
- Dark timber furniture
- Natural textures (rattan, reed and sisal, cane and bamboo)
- Plants everywhere – think tropical plants with big green leaves like palms and ferns
- Eclectic fabrics (soft, light and white sheers)
- Layer textures and colours with botanical prints, paisleys, ikats, batiks and animal prints
- White or dark timber plantation shutters
