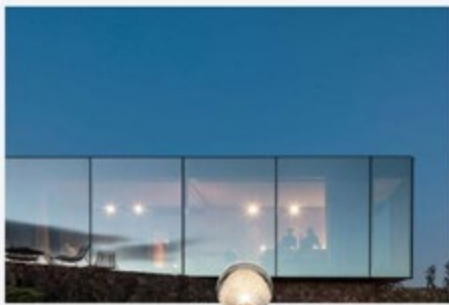


## CONTEMPORARY
